



Club Basketball Rules & Regulations

2010 Roster Deadline: Wednesday, 2/03/10
Coaches Meeting: Tuesday, 2/09/10, 6:30pm @ the Kids, Incorporated WareHouse

High School Federation Rules will be used with the following exceptions:

- All players must be on the roster and must have a picture ID on file in the Kids, Incorporated office. Players should drop by the Kids, Incorporated office during business hours (Mon.-Fri. 9:00am to 5:00pm) to have their picture made. All players need to have their picture ID made by Wednesday, 2/10/10. Use of an ineligible player will result in an automatic forfeit and the player and coach being suspended for the remainder of the season.
- Players may play up one (1) grade level.
 - A player may not play up two (2) or more grades.
 - A player may not play down a grade level.
- Players may participate on only one (1) team.
- Teams may not add any other players to their roster after Wednesday, 2/17/10.
- Uniforms for each team must be the same and jerseys may not contain duplicate numbers.
- Each team will receive four (4) one-minute timeouts per game.
- Halftime will be 3 minutes.
- Games will consist of two (2) sixteen-minute halves with a running clock. The clock will stop during free throws and timeouts. We will use a regulation clock during the last two minutes of the game.
- Overtime will consist of a three (3) minute period. If the score remains tied after the three-minute overtime period, another three-minute period will follow. Subsequent periods will follow if necessary, until a winner is determined. Each team will receive one (1) timeout per overtime period, plus any remaining timeouts from regulation play. In any overtime period, a regulation clock will be used during the last minute of play.
- Technical Fouls - Individuals receiving two (2) technical fouls in a particular game will be ejected from the game and asked to leave the facility. You will also be issued an additional two-game suspension. This rule applies to coaches, players, and spectators.
- Kids, Incorporated operates under a "zero tolerance" policy with respect to physical violence. Anyone participating in a physical altercation will be removed from the premises and prohibited from returning. Our goal is to provide a safe environment for our players, coaches, and spectators. There is absolutely no room for physical violence in our program. We have worked very hard to provide referees who also share our philosophy. The referees have been charged with:
 - 1) maintaining a safe playing environment,
 - 2) displaying professional courtesy to all players, coaches and spectators and
 - 3) enforcing the rules of the game.
- Game time is forfeit time!
- The referees will have the final authority for each game.
